



Building 1: (east building on site layout). 3 story climate controlled self-storage facility. The image above shows how the building facing Mallard Creek Church Rd. The architect is styling this building based on the above building type. Architectural glazing will be used to expose storage doors to the public realm.

Buildings 2-14: Single story, drive-up self-storage units. The buildings placed on the south property line and the buffer to the north will be used to block storage doors from adjacent uses to the north and south. The image on the next page shows how these buildings will appear to adjacent uses. Roof elements will be used to break up the appearance of long linear walls

Building 15: (west building on site layout). This will also be a 3-story climate controlled facility. Use of architectural glazing and building signage facing I-85 to gain visibility from Northbound off ramp traffic on the west side of the property.
